Stars 'suffering in silence'

A CAMPAIGNER will meet with football chiefs to help them provide support to seven secretly gay players.

Amal Fashanu – niece of gay footballer Justin Fashanu – will meet with the Professional Footballers' Association. She is battling to put an end to homophobia in the game. Her uncle Justin killed himself in 1998 after becoming the first professional player to come out. Amal said: "For a long time the game has been ignoring the issue, but at long last this appears to be

"They want to do all they can to make sure any player who wants to make that step is supported." Two players Amal is supporting are Premier League stars who don't feel able to go public, fearing a backlash from fans. Her dad, ex-Wimbledon striker John, is supporting her efforts. He paid his brother Justin to keep quiet about his sexuality, a decision which he has publicly said he has regretted "every day".

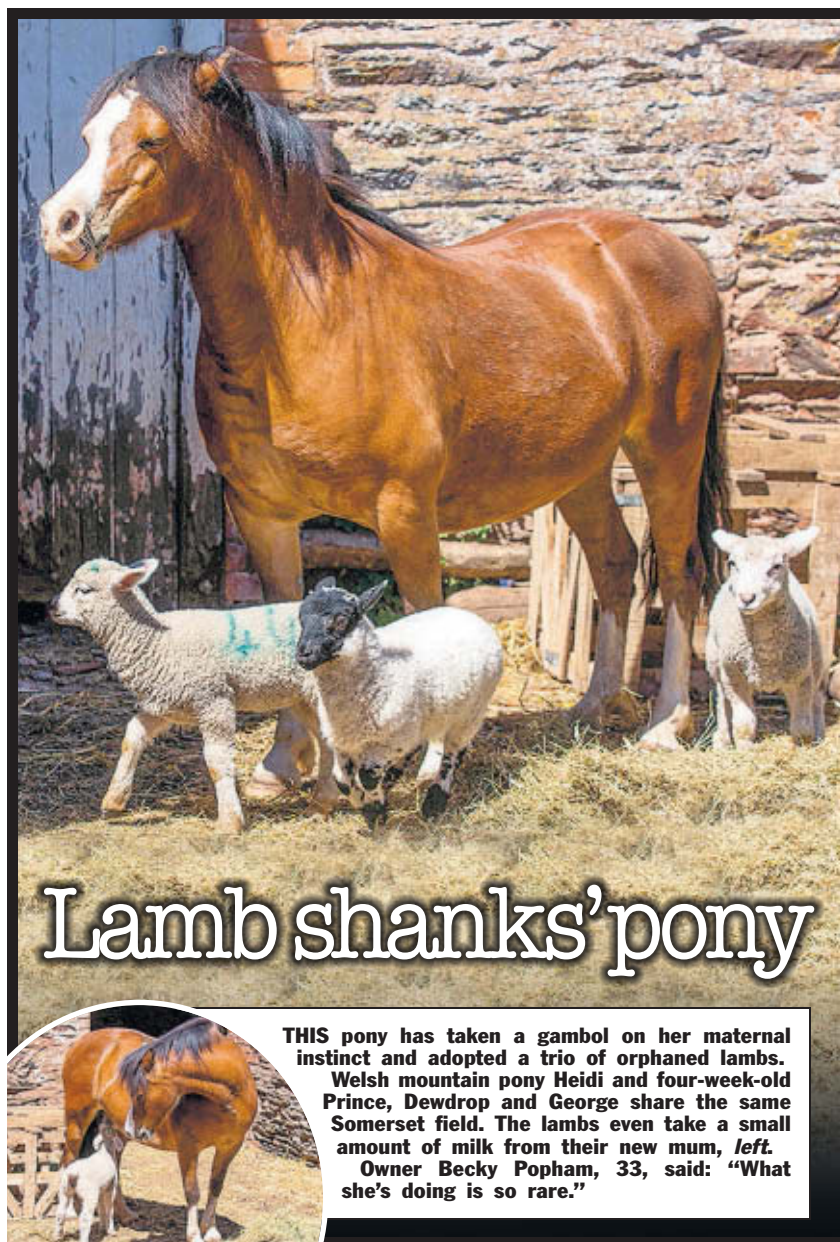
Different Julie after cancer

DAME Julie Walters says she feels like "a different person" to who she was before she battled cancer. The star, 70, said that when she is now asked about being in the Harry Potter or Mamma Mia! movies, "it feels like it should be someone else answering, not me". Dame Julie had a bowel cancer operation almost two years ago. She told Good Morning Britain she went to her GP with "slight discomfort" of indigestion, stomach pains and vomiting. Doctors diagnosed stage three bowel cancer and removed 30cms of her colon with two tumours. But she said: "I had a scan in February and that was clear, so, yeah, as far as I know everything is fine."
